- Establish a clear and consistent design theme for Long Jetty
- Look at opportunities for businesses

CURRENT PROJECTS

- 1 Painting of existing buildings along The Entrance Road
- Planter Boxes, Flag pole banners & Spherical bollards
- 3 Street Furniture Retro Benches
- 4 General footpath upgrades

PROPOSED PROJECTS

- 5 Main street footpath upgrades (consistent design theme)
- Re-zone land between Thompson Street and Pacific Street from 2(a) to 3 (a)
- Possible upgrade of old cinema complex
- 8 Street scape improvements including possible footpath widening in key areas to create alfresco areas
- Consolidation of parking, street trees and WSUD initiatives on side streets (Toowoon Bay Rd, Pacific St & Thompson St)
- 10 Street trees and landscape improvements
- 11 Focal point at northern gateway


CURRENT PROJECTS

POSSIBLE PROJECTS

- 5 Improve existing toilet block
- 6 New boat ramp & Carpark
- 7 Mobile food outlets
- 8 Provide free WiFi access
- Feature landscaping along southern gateway entry
- 10 Kiosk / Restaurant / Estuary Management Education Centre
- 11 Possible expansion of playground area

















CURRENT PROJECTS:

- 1 General footpath upgrades
- 2 Continue to promote the diverse mix of businesses
- 3 Flag pole banners and spherical bollards
- 4 Facade painting

POSSIBLE PROJECTS:

- Provide a unifying element such as street trees and landscaping in what is currently a mix of businesses and architectural forms.
- 6 Opportunity to improve parking and utilise side streets and connecting roads.
- 7 Opportunity to define southern gateway through the built form
