Subject: **THE ENTRANCE POLICE STATION.**

Dear Grant,

At our Executive Committee Meeting held on Tuesday, 6th July the subject of the future of The Entrance Police Station was discussed. It was resolved that I write to you to obtain a commitment that The Entrance Police Station remains a fully manned station.

The matter arises because there is a persistent rumor that with the construction of a new Police Station at Wyong that The Entrance Police Station will be downgraded. The value of the property in Denning Street was seen as another reason for the existing station to be closed to raise much needed revenue. There is already community concern that The Entrance Police Station is undermanned. Concerns were expressed as to how could Police respond to calls to The Entrance if they have to come from Wyong, especially in times of peak traffic on Wyong Road, when traffic is at a standstill.

It would be appreciated if you could please give a commitment to TEPCP that The Entrance Police Station remains fully manned as at present and does not revert to the unsatisfactory unmanned type of Police Station.
