The O₂ arena

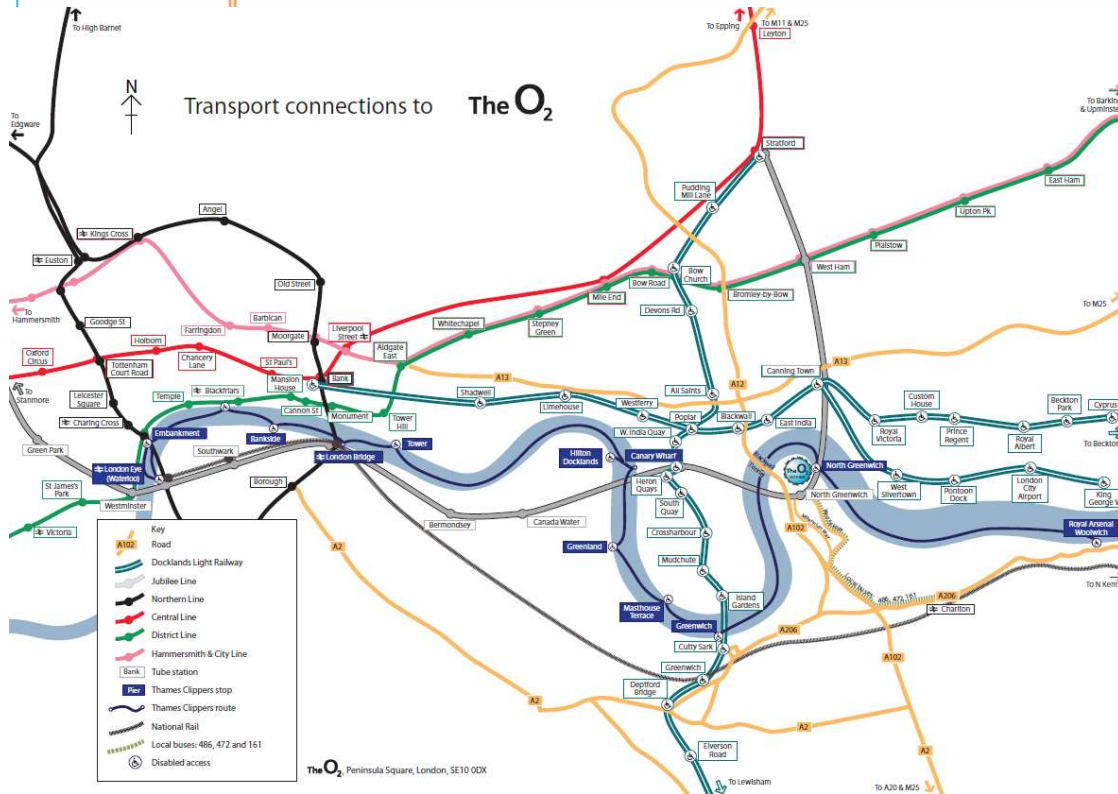
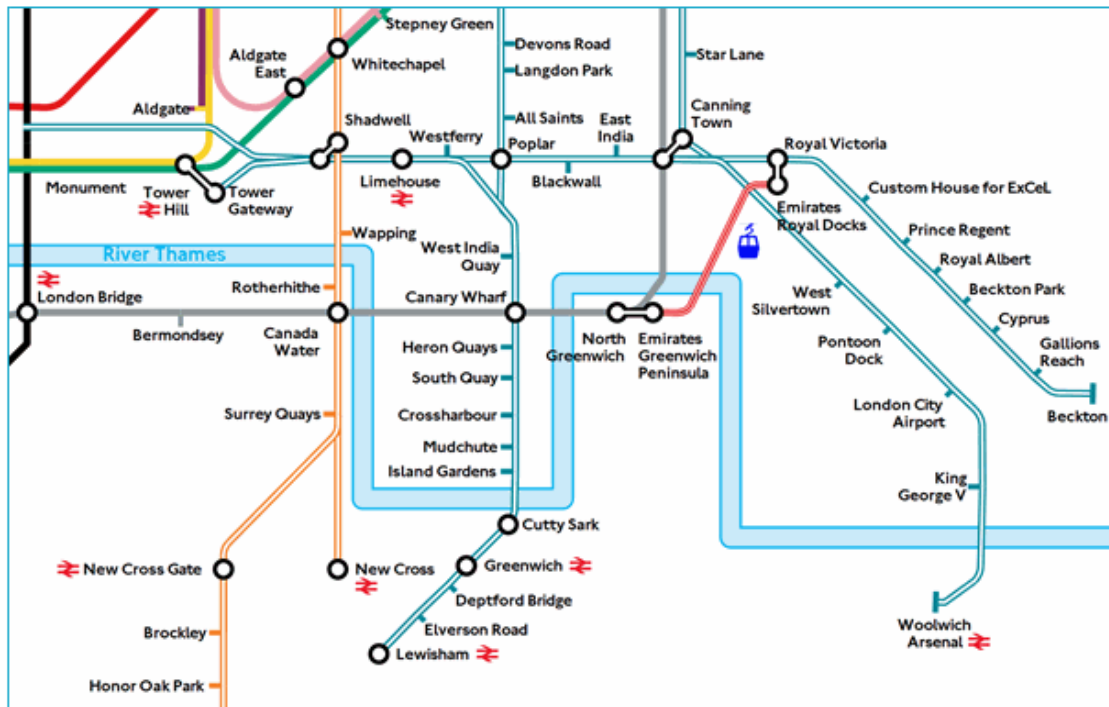






The O₂ is a large entertainment district on the Greenwich peninsula in South East London, England, including an [indoor arena](#), a music club, a [Cineworld](#) cinema, an exhibition space, piazzas, bars and restaurants. It was built largely within the former [Millennium Dome](#), a large dome-shaped building built to house an exhibition celebrating the turn of the third millennium; as such, *The Dome* remains a name in common usage for the venue.

The dome is one of the largest of its type in the world. Externally, it appears as a large white marquee with twelve 100 m-high yellow support towers, one for each month of the year, or each hour of the clock face, representing the role played by Greenwich Mean Time. In plan view it is circular, 365 m in circumference — one metre for each day of the year — with scalloped edges. It has become one of the United Kingdom's most recognisable landmarks. It can easily be seen on aerial photographs of London.

Cineworld

When we say our 11 screen multiplex cinema is pretty magnificent we aren't exaggerating. The giant main auditorium seats up to 770 movie fans and has the biggest 3D cinema screen in Europe.

Up at The O2 Climb Activities

Taking up to 90 minutes, Up at The O2 is an exhilarating experience which will take you on an uplifting guided expedition over the roof of The O2 via a tensile fabric walkway. Suspended 2m above the surface of The O2 tent canvas, the walkway is 52m above ground level at its highest point and 320m long.

At its steepest point the walkway has an incline of 28 degrees on the way up and 30 degrees on the way back down and has a slight bounce to it to replicate the surface of the tent. There's a hand rail on the walkway and a balustrade on the observation platform. There are no seats available during the ascent and descent and limited seating to be used for emergencies only on the viewing platform and no toilets available during the climb itself but available before and after. Before you climb, you'll meet your Climbing Guide who'll take you through everything you need to know and give you a climb suit, shoes (if necessary) and a safety harness. You'll then make your way onto the walkway, via a short set of stairs, or lift, to the base of the tent ready to start your climb.

There is an observation platform (12m diameter) at the summit where you can take in spectacular 360° views of London and its many landmarks. Once on the platform you will be able to move freely on the platform to enjoy the views before your descent. At all other times you'll be attached to a guide rope on the walkway to keep you safe and your Climbing Guide will be nearby to help you and answer any questions.

Climbing Guides won't supervise you on a one to one basis and you'll be responsible for ensuring that you and any under 18s you supervise comply with the safety instructions and Safety Rules and Policies given to you in the briefing room and the instructions of your Climbing Guide.
