Joy Of Life Fountain



This fountain, on the eastern edge of Hyde Park, forms part of the Diana Princess of Wales Memorial Walk. This Constance Fund fountain was sculpted by T. B. Huxley-Jones in 1963, but was recently rebuilt.

The Constance Fund was set up by the widow, Constance, of the artist Sigismund C.H.Goetze in his memory. Its aim was “to encourage and promote the art of sculpture in London Parks.”
